



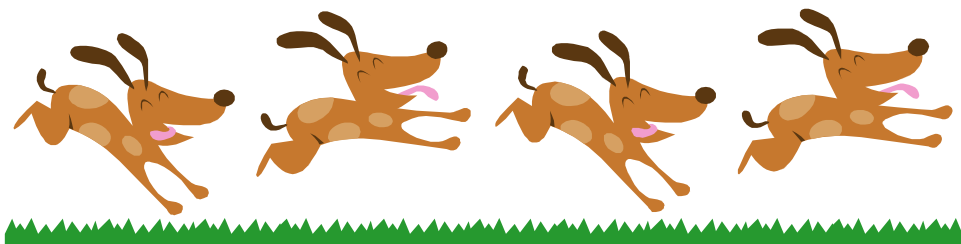

# Doggie Play Care Registration Packet

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## ***Welcome to Diamond Creek Pet Retreat's Play Care Program!***

Thank you for choosing Diamond Creek for your dog's play care needs. We are confident that you will find our facility and services to be truly unique!

This Play Care registration packet contains information on our Play Care services and requirements. Please review the following pages and complete all forms prior to your evaluation meeting. At the time of your evaluation, a member of our staff will go over the materials with you and answer any questions.

### ***Who Can Play?***

- ❖ Dogs over 16 weeks (***Certificate of Spay/Neuter required for dogs over 6 months of age***)
- ❖ Dogs current on all required vaccines, fecal screening and free of external parasites (fleas/ticks).
- ❖ Dogs that are social with other dogs (regardless of size, breed, gender, age) and people.
- ❖ Dogs without possession issues of toys or food.
- ❖ Dogs that have been crate trained at home during active times.
- ❖ Retreat dogs that have been through evaluation.
- ❖ Dogs that have been assessed through our evaluation interview and found suitable for the Play Care environment.

### ***Evaluation Process:***

We want to make your evaluation go smoothly and start your experience off on the right paw at Diamond Creek. The evaluation will be done in two parts, the details of which can be viewed on pages 13-14 of this packet. These are the forms your evaluator will use to assess your dog. During the evaluation we will also perform a thorough wellness check on your pet to establish a base-line of their physical appearance.

Please have all the forms listed above completed prior to Part 1 of your evaluation so we can use your entire appointment to get to know you and your pet(s). We also ask that you bring a copy of your dog's most recent vaccination history that we may keep on file for future reference. Our Play Care guests must be current on the following vaccinations: Rabies, DHPP and Bordatella. Your vet may fax this information to us at 860-491-3906 prior to your evaluation. Following Part 1 of their evaluation, all approved dogs will need to have a stool sample negative for parasites prior to entering our Play Care environment for Part 2 of the evaluation.

Please contact our office to schedule your appointment for Part 1 of your dog's evaluation which will take approximately 30 minutes. Dogs approved after Part 1 may schedule Part 2 of their evaluations on Play Care days at 50% of the daily rate so we can observe your dog in an actual play environment.

## ***Play Care Services & Overview:***

### **Hours:**

- Full or ½ days, Monday – Friday
- Full Day: 7:30 am – 5:30 pm (5–10 hours)
- Half Day: or up to 5 hours between 7:30 am – 5:30 pm

### **Requirements:**

- Certificate of neuter or spay by 6 months of age. ***No intact animals over the age of 6 months will be permitted.***
- Dog must be current for all of the following vaccinations:
  - Distemper or passing titer
  - Hepatitis
  - Para influenza
  - Rabies
  - Canine Cough (every 6 months)
- Negative stool sample (every 6 months)
- Parasite free (fleas, ticks & skin irritation) checked every visit
- A thorough Wellness Check will be completed at the evaluation interview

### **Rates**

- **Single Dog:**
  - Full Day: \$27.00
  - Half Day: \$20.00
- **Multiple Dogs** from same household:
  - Full Day: \$22.86 per dog
  - Half Day: \$16.92 per dog
- **Retreat Dogs:** Daily accommodation rate + \$22.86 for single dog
- Mid-day meals or medications can be provided at an additional \$2 per dog (no breakfasts or dinners).

**Late Charge:** Play Care services end at 5:30 pm. Dogs still in our care at 5:30 will be moved to an alternate crating area to await pickup. If pets are not picked up by 5:45 pm additional costs will apply unless prior arrangements have been made. For more detail see “Play Care Service Agreement” #2 on page 12.

## ***Before, During & After:***

### ***What to do at Home Prior to Drop-off:***

- All dogs should be fed their morning meal and given any medications and supplements at home.
- Pack any lunch or mid-day medications and be sure to label with dog's name and date.

### ***Upon Arrival at Diamond Creek Play Care:***

- Please give your dog a quick walk for elimination prior to drop-off at our Play Care program. There are scoops and metal cans to use to pickup after your pet.
- Make sure all belongings are labeled with dog's name and family last name for easy identification.
- Complete the Daily Roster sheet located in the check-in area (see sample attached as page 15).

### ***Sample Schedule:***

- 7:30 – 8:00 am: Arrival and greetings, indoor play
- 8:00 – 10:00 am: Outside play time
- 10:00 – 11:00 am: Indoor rest and relax time
- 11:00 am – 1:00 pm: Outside play time
- 12:30 – 2:00 pm: Care Giver transition during rest time, lunch and any mid-day medications given
- 2:00 – 4:00 pm: Outside play time
- 4:00 – 5:30 pm: Inside free time and pickup

### ***Coming Home After a Day of Fun:***

- Your dog has been playing with friends all day.
  - If he was at home he would have been sleeping, making rounds of the house, finding a new spot to sleep, and repeating...not too much activity.
  - ***After a day at Play Care he will be tired.***
- It is common for dogs to ***not*** want their normal level of activity at home the night of pickup or even the next morning.
  - They may only play fetch for a few minutes instead of for two hours, or just want to sit and cuddle.
  - They may not want to go for their normal walk, but instead sniff around the yard while you catch up on some yard maintenance.
- They may be sore after playing all day.
  - They may seem stiff the following morning and take a little while to loosen up.
  - Don't be alarmed, this is normal; they had a really good workout and used a lot of muscles more than they typically would.
  - However, if your dog seems to be heavily favoring one limb or non-weight bearing you will want to monitor this and if it continues throughout the day without improvement, it could be a sign of something more serious and you should contact your vet. ***Do not*** bring the dog back to Play Care until the issue is resolved.
- Dogs may be damp or dirty from playing in the pool or snow (pending season) or from potty breaks in the rain.
- Some dogs may seem overly drooly or moist around their mouth/chest area from happy drool or water play. Others may have drool spots from playing with their friends.

Within 2 weeks of starting Play Care some dogs may get diarrhea from shared water, toys, etc. This is normal and you should not be alarmed, however please do not bring the dog back to Play Care until they are symptom free for 24 hours without medication. If symptoms last longer than 24 hours your vet should be contacted.

## ***Example Behavioral Referral***

For dogs that pass the evaluation to enter the Play Care program who then develop behaviors indicating group play may not be the best for your pet, we will refer you to our head trainer and behavioral consultant, Laurey Weiner.

In most cases we will issue a behavioral warning for the first occurrence and alter the play structure/playmates to better fit a dog's personality. Upon a second occurrence the dog will be removed from the program and the referral structure below will apply.

### **Play Care Behavioral Referral**

Sometimes group dynamics evolve that change a dog's behavior in a play group, and for the benefit of the dog, discontinuing the program at this time will be best.

In order to help you with the behavior that prompted this decision, we would like to refer you to our behavioral consultant, Laurey Weiner, CPDT-KA, and also the Canine Sports Center's head pet obedience instructor, or another CSC obedience instructor of your choice.

The Canine Sports Center waives their portion of the consultation fee for all behavioral referrals from Play Care. The discounted cost of the consultation will be \$60.00 for a one-hour meeting with the instructor. This offer is good for any meeting within one month of your dog's final day of Play Care.

## ***Diamond Creek Play Care Service Agreement:***

THIS **DOG PLAY CARE SERVICE AGREEMENT** ("Agreement") IS MADE ON THIS \_\_\_\_ DAY OF \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_, BETWEEN **DIAMOND CREEK LLC** ("DCPR") AND \_\_\_\_\_ (hereinafter known as "Pet Owner"). WHERE PET OWNER WISHES TO RECEIVE DOG PLAY CARE SERVICES FROM DCPR AND DCPR AGREES TO PROVIDE SUCH SERVICE UNDER THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS BELOW. THE PARTIES, INTENDING TO BE LEGALLY BOUND, HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

**Holiday Closures:** DCPR is closed for Play Care on the following holidays: New Year's Eve, New Year's Day, Easter Eve, Easter, Memorial Day, 4<sup>th</sup> of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Eve, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve, and Christmas Day

1. Pricing for services are detailed in the "Services & Overview" section of the Play Care registration packet. Prices are subject to change. Payment for all services is required at the time of pickup.
2. After 5:30 pm pickup: Play Care room transitions to training between 5:30 – 6:00 pm for training classes starting at 6:00 pm. Special pickups after 5:45 pm can be arranged at an addition rate of \$2.00 per extra 15-minutes. **FACILITY CLOSSES AT 7PM**, any pets still in our care at that time will be checked-in to overnight accommodations at current accommodation rate.
3. Play Care is not suitable for all dogs, and some dogs may not be accepted into DCPR's Play Care setting. Should a dog develop behaviors inappropriate for the play care environment following acceptance to the program removal from the program may be necessary. All rules, screening procedures and medical requirements are subject to change at the discretion of Diamond Creek LLC.
4. Diamond Creek LLC will provide a cage-less play area for your pet during Play Care hours for exercise and socialization with other dogs under the supervision of a Diamond Creek Care Giver. However, crating is a part of the structured day for brief rest periods and dogs must be acclimated to crating at home while the house is active prior to entering the program.
5. Should your dog become ill or require medical attention, you are authorizing Diamond Creek LLC to do whatever is necessary to provide care for your pet, including seeking veterinarian services and medicines. *You are agreeing to be responsible for payment of services and medications rendered, including any Diamond Creek expenses involved.* The fees for emergency vet visits (in addition to the vet fees) are based on the time required and trip expenses. Charges from Diamond Creek can range from about \$25.00 to \$50.00+ for staff time and trip expenses.
6. By signing below, Pet Owner agrees to not hold DCPR, nor anyone affiliated with or employed by DCPR responsible for any injury to Pet Owner, Pet Owner's dog or family and friends brought to DCPR. Signing below also indicates that the Pet Owner is responsible for any damage caused by their dog to another person or dog while on the grounds of DCPR.
7. Pet Owner certifies they are the rightful/lawful owner of the dog, or is the authorized agent of the actual owner whose name is listed above.
8. Pet Owner is responsible for procuring veterinary services and documentation to certify the pet is current on vaccines for Rabies, DHPP (Distemper, Hepatitis, Parainfluenza and Parvo), and Bordatella (Canine Cough), for insuring the pet is free from internal and external (fleas & ticks) parasitic problems and performing routine fecal screening for worms every 6-months.
